The Wickliffe Italian-American Club was established in 1933 for community members of Italian descent. Our facility includes a club room, a pavilion grounds area and nine covered bocce courts which are occupied weekly from April through October with leagues, rentals, and live events. One of the biggest, and perhaps most prized events held by the club is the Cleveland Challenge Cup of Bocce tournament. The tournament draws an estimated 10,000 people including 100+ teams from 15+ states plus areas of Canada. It is a three-day event consisting of live music, live entertainment, food & souvenir vendors, beverages and cash prizes to the top remaining teams. Each year The Wickliffe Italian-American Club hosts The Cleveland Challenge Cup of Bocce in late August and is listed as one of the largest bocce tournaments in the country.
